We help them financially to pay their bills and for handicapped to buy their artificial hands/legs etc. This year we extended medical help not only for people in our locality but to those from other settlements also. All monks of our monastery are having free medical, food, accommodation, clothing, educational needs..everything from our Charity.

NEW TEMPLE PROJECT: Existing temple is too small to accommodate all the monks during puja and moreover there is leakage inside temple which makes us difficulty to held puja inside temple during rainy season. We have purchased most of the materials in advance to save time and to avoid price escalation of building materials in future. New Temple project will start from the first week of January 2009.

PUJA AND RELIGIOUS FUNCTION: Every year we perform different puja like: Guru Padmasambhawa wrathful puja, Hundred deities(shitro puja), Achi puja, Kyobpa Jigtensumgon Parinirvana anniversary puja, 100000 times achi tsok, Dharma protector, Gampopa



Puja, Mahakala Puja, Phakmo Drubchoe, Summer retreat etc. Apart from these we perform puja as requested by dharma friends and also for well being of all sentient beings. With request from local people monks visit their home and perform prayer.





Above pictures are taken in our monastery dining hall. Previously when we don't have separate dinning hall monks use to have break fast ,lunch and dinner outside at open field and some monks take their food at dormitory or room to have. During rainy season we face lots of problem. With the help from sponsors we build dinning hall attached with kitchen and on first floor we have big multi purpose hall. All the tables, bench and other necessary things are purchased with the help from donors. Now with this new dinning hall we don't have to worry during rainy season, all monks are having their meals without any disturbance from rain, wind and sunny days.
